Deputy O'Brien and Mayor Mahony both laid wreaths at the war memorial in the graveyard to those who lost their lives in WW1 and WW2, and indeed those who lost their lives in conflicts since. Minister O'Brien gave a speech about the importance of the Annual Remembrace to remember those Irish men and women who fought in the Great Wars of the last Century. The Mayor of Fingal endorsed these comments and stated that his own Father served in the RAF during WW2 and a couple of his Great Uncles and other relatives had served in WW1. The Rector led the prayers, and the last post was played and there was a time of silence. The Royal Dublin Fusiliers Banner was flown at the event. 


Family Bingo Night
