Donabate's 1937 Parish Hall Upgrade

The original parish hall in Donabate was built circa 1937, and has just recently undergone a major refurbishment. The upgraded hall has had a complete internal refit, including a new kitchen, new toilets, and a new fire system. The grounds have all been cleared and landscaped. At the same time, the traditional features have been restored to blend the old with the new. We hope this investment will see this 83-year-old hall continue for many generations to come.

Donabate and Lusk Parish Development Project

The parish development project is progressing. The next phase will see one acre of the glebe field go on the market with full planning permission. The proceeds from the sale will fund the development of a new community hub that we hope will further integrate the church into the wider community.

Online Sunday Services

We started recording Sunday Services from the Rectory during the lockdown. The services proved popular, with hundreds of views some weeks. They are recorded over Zoom to ensure adherence with the Covid-19 restrictions. Originally recorded in the Rectory, once the churches re-opened, we started recording from the churches. We had planned on stopping at the end of the summer but due to the popularity of the online services and especially the fresh Covid-19 restrictions which have closed the churches again, we have decided to continue.
